TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS (TPS) - CAMEROON



ARE YOU FROM CAMEROON?

If you are from Cameroon or lived in Cameroon you might qualify for temporary protected status.

WHAT IS TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS (TPS):

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is for people who left their home countries because of conflict or natural disasters. The U.S government decides which countries are on the TPS list.

A person with TPS:

- is protected from deportation,
- can work legally in the United States, and
- may travel with permission.

TPS for people from Cameroon ends on December 7, 2023, and TPS can be extended. The U.S. government announces extensions and when to sign up again ("re-register").

DO YOU QUALIFY FOR TPS? YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR TPS IF:

- You are from Cameroon or you lived in Cameroon;
- You came to the U.S. by April 14, 2022; and
- You apply for TPS by December 7, 2023.

NOTE: Some trips outside the U.S., crimes, or other problems can disqualify you from TPS.
